

EXCERPTS FROM THE LICENCE AGREEMENT for ORGANIC CHEMISTRY SOFTWARE:

- The Internet resource may only be used by your institution, its students and its employees. If the licence you have bought is limited to 'in class' use only, you may not access it from home or from other schools.
- The User name and password to access the Software may not be shared with an unlicensed user.
- The licence will be terminated if this or any of the licence conditions are breached.
- You may use the resource only for the purpose of teaching or learning chemistry. You may not store the software for offline use or record, copy, or create works based on the software. You may not disassemble or modify any part of the Software.
- You may not sell, loan, sublicense or transfer the User name and password that gives access to the Software. The user should not access the resource from public spaces such as Internet cafés.
- You agree to be bound by the terms of the Licence Agreement if you use or access this Software. The Software is licensed not sold and is protected by international copyright law and national laws.



The full END-USER LICENCE AGREEMENT follows:

END-USER LICENCE AGREEMENT FOR ORGANIC CHEMISTRY SOFTWARE

You agree to be bound by the terms of the Licence Agreement if you use, access or install this Software, an educational resource about Organic Chemistry. The Software is intended for individual users particularly students and teachers in schools and colleges.

We provide users with the right to use the resources according to the type of licence purchased. We respectfully state that the software be used within the limits of the licence that you have bought or has been bought for your use. The resources are licensed in a range of configurations and the type of licence granted to you by us defines how you are allowed to use the Software. The document sets out to explain meanings of terms we may use in our descriptive materials. For uses beyond these limits, please contact your supplier to discuss how you may upgrade your licence.

DEFINITIONS:

A 'computer' is a device on which the software output can be displayed. The 'Software' takes form in various configurations and is otherwise called 'the resource' or 'online portal'.

'The licensee', 'you' or 'your' refers to the person or institution using or intending to use the Software, on whose behalf you are accepting this Agreement;

'Us', 'we' or 'our' refers to 'White House eLearning'

An 'institution' is an educational establishment, which must be wholly at a single postal address. For each different postal address, a new Licence is required, whether or not the sites are part of the same organisation.

'Forever' is defined as a period of ten years.

ABOUT ONLINE LICENCES GENERALLY

Online licences to use the resources to learn or teach are granted for a limited number of users and a limited period of time depending on the type of licence purchased. The Software may not be downloaded or stored for offline use. Access to the Software may be limited until payment for it has been confirmed. The Licensee should access the resource from a limited number of computers and not from public spaces such as Internet cafés.

INDIVIDUAL OR HOME USER ONLINE LICENCE

An 'Individual Online User Licence' permits only the Licensee to access the Software. The User name and password to access the Software may never be shared with another user. The licence will be terminated, for example, if there is access from different computers at the same time.

INSTITUTION ONLINE LICENCE

When an Institution Online Licence is provided, the software may only be used by the Licensee, its students and its employees. A User name and password to access the Software may never be shared with users not belonging to the Institution or else the Licence will be terminated.

The Licensee should access the resource from computers within the institution and from computers which are personal computers of its students and its employees and also not access from public spaces such as Internet cafés.

EVALUATION LICENCE

If an evaluation licence is provided to you, the software may only be used for this purpose, and not for teaching or studying. Evaluation licences cannot be extended for use outside of the institution to which they were granted.

COMPUTER LICENCE

A 'Computer Licence' permits you to install the Software on a single computer. Multiple 'Computer Licences' let you install the Software on the number of computers specified by the licence.

Example Licences:

COM1 - all topics, licence for one computer

COM5 - all topics, licences for 5 computers

NETWORK SERVER LICENCE

A Network Server Licence lets you install the software on a single computer and access the Software from a fixed number of computers on site. The fixed number permitted should be stated on the purchase invoice.

A Network Server Licence is no longer valid if the number of students on roll rises higher than the upper limit of the Network Server Licence band where this has been set. Example Licences:

NET30 - licence for one network server for 30 concurrent users in an institution with less than 5000 students on roll

NET80 - licence for one network server for 80 concurrent users in an institution with less than 5000 students on roll

NETWORK SERVER ANYWHERE OR EXTRANET OR INTERNET LICENCE

A Network Server Licence with extranet or anywhere extension licences access to the server from the homes of students and employees of your institution. The Licence does not permit commercial exploitation of such access or storage of the software for offline use. Example:

EXTRANET80 - licence for access from home by 80 concurrent users.

ACTIVATION

Where relevant a key for your licence will be supplied to you when you provide us with an installation ID for a licensed computer. We will uphold your entitlement to licence keys until you provide a code for each computer in your license entitlement. Licence keys applied for by your institution or its members will be subtracted from your license entitlement.

UPGRADING

When you upgrade from an earlier version of the Software, the Licence Agreement for that earlier version is replaced by this one.

RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF THE SOFTWARE

You may use the resources only for personal purposes or teaching or learning purposes related to classes at school. You have no right to any resale or commercial use of the software and its resources. You may not, except to the extent which is permitted by law:

- o modify the Software, or any part of it, beyond facilities discussed in our documentation.
- o use copies of the software that exceed the number permitted by software licence.
- o reproduce, duplicate, copy, sell, resell, give, visit, rent, lease, loan, sublicense or distribute the Software, or exploit it for commercial gain;
- o record animation, copy a screen, create works based on, or featuring the Software or its output; reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble the Software or any part of it.

o use the software on Computers outside of the Licensee's postal address except as an employee or student of the Licensee.
o transfer the Software and your rights under this Agreement as part of the sale or transfer of your Computer. This does not apply to bulk licensing schemes or evaluation licences.

COPYRIGHT

The Software menu, html, Javascript, Adobe Flash screens and animation is entirely owned by 'White House elearning' and is licensed not sold. These are protected by national and international copyright laws.

PLUGINS, CHIME MODELS

Plug-ins and Chime models do not form part of this package or agreement. The plug-in to view animation is owned by Adobe and governed by their terms. The plug-in to view 3D models is owned by Symx and governed by their terms. 'Chime' models (MOL; PBD files) created by us are hereby released into the public domain. Other 'Chime' models may or may not have owners and licence terms.

LICENCE TERMINATION

If you do not comply with any term or condition or you are found to breach the licence conditions described in this document we may terminate the Licence to use the resource with immediate effect and demand to cease the breaching and if necessary rectify the effects of such breaching. In such an event, you must disable all copies of the Software and all of its component parts. Fees paid will not be refunded.

REFUNDS AND CANCELLATIONS

There is no provision to cancel a purchased license and refund the fee paid but a licence can be upgraded. You can contact us for further information in this regard.

DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTIES

The resource made available to the users are provided on an 'as is' and 'as available' basis, unless otherwise specified in writing. We make no warranty that the resource will meet the user's requirements and the service will be uninterrupted, timely, secure or error-free. The user expressly agrees that his/her use of the resource is at his/her sole risk.

LIMITED LIABILITY

To the maximum extent permitted by law, we shall not be liable for any other damages whatsoever arising out of the use or inability to use the Software, even if we have been notified about the possibility of such damages. We provide no warranty of faultless or uninterrupted access to the portal and its resources.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

The minimum technical requirements must be fulfilled by the user

- OS: Windows 2000 or Windows XP or Windows Vista.
- Browser: Windows IE6 or IE7; Flash 8 player; cookies enabled; Javascript enabled; Chime allowed. Installed editions require Java JRE 6 update 1.
- 900MHz Intel Pentium III or equivalent processor; 256MB RAM. Screen: 1024x768 resolution; 16 bit high colour depth; DirectX 9 compatible integrated video chip with 128MB Ram; 64MB DirectX 9 compatible standalone graphics card preferred

LIMITED WARRANTY

We warrant that for a period of ninety days from the supply date that the Software will perform substantially in accordance with the online brochure at the time of purchase; and any physical materials on which we deliver the Software to you will be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use.

Our entire liability, and your only remedy, shall be, at our sole discretion, will the return of the price you paid. This Limited Warranty is void if the failure of the Software has resulted from accident, abuse, use outside the technical requirements or misapplication.

NO OTHER WARRANTIES
